I actively participate in staff engagement/shared governance on my unit.

<b>Coach (educator)</b>				
I understand learning preferences (eg, auditory, visual, hands on) and can adjust my teaching strategies accordingly.				
I know the orientation outcomes for my specialty.				
I know how to complete the orientation forms.				
I have the knowledge and skills to provide effective feedback to others.				
<b>Protector</b>				
I provide a safe environment for my patients.				
I speak up as my patient's advocate.				
I provide a safe space for my colleagues at work.
